1: The home institution will nominate students to HKR in accordance with the mutually agreed number of exchange places.

2: HKR sends link & instruction to in-coming students to apply.

- 3: Incoming student creates account on "Mobility-Online" to begin online application.
- 4: Students upload passport photo.

5: Students choose courses and print the application form.

- 6: Students upload the signed application form and transcript of record.
- 7: Students print the signed admission letter.
- 8: Students fill in online accommodation application form.
- 9: Students fill in arrival time.

Teacher Education A Swedish perspective

A high-quality university with a big heart

Kristianstad University offers a wide range of programmes and courses for future and current teachers. We have undergraduate programmes in pre-school, primary, secondary and post compulsory education.

Teacher education at Kristianstad University is based on basic democratic values, modern childhood and knowledge about individual children's learning and development.

Courses for exchange students

Kristianstad University offers different packages of courses suitable not only for Teacher Education students but also for students with Sociological, Psychological and (Special) Educational interest.

The courses are all related to teacher education: pedagogical work and the idea of a school for all. Exchange students have the possibility to both study courses and take part in a school placement. The language of instruction is English.

Preschool and Primary Education

Swedish preschool is a place to grow for children between 1 and 5 years old. There is a focus on basic values such as playing together, tolerance and consideration for others. Outdoor activities are key and children play outside at every opportunity.

Swedish compulsory schooling consists of four stages for children between the ages of 6 and 15: preschool year, primary school grades 1-3, followed by grades 4-6 and then high school grades 7-9. Children between ages 6 and 13 are also offered out-of-school care before and after school hours. Read more at



Sweden

Sweden is one of the largest countries in Europe, with varied scenery and climate. From north to south you can find extensive forests, numerous lakes and a long coastline.

The landscape as well as the climate changes a lot, from the wild and colder regions of the north to the milder and flatter landscape of the south.

Sweden is not only forests and lakes but a modern and fast developing country. In a nutshell, "Sweden is a country of opportunities offering a high quality of life with the human and nature in mind. (Swedish Institute)".

Skåne

Skåne is the southernmost region of Sweden. Danish until 1658, it still keeps a bit of Denmark in its flag and in the "Skånska" the dialect spoken in the area. Together with the Danish Zealand, it belongs to the Øresund Region, one of the fastest expanding areas in northern Europe. It is the most populated area of Sweden but you can still find wild nature, lakes, forests and small villages along the cost.

Malmö, the third largest city in Sweden, is the main centre of Skåne. Thanks to its connection to Copenhagen through the Øresund bridge, the city is quickly developing and is becoming an important centre for all the Scandinavian countries. Modern and old at the same time, Malmö offers a great variety of activities for all tastes. "Before studying in Sweden, my impression about Sweden is that it has a prosperous economy, advanced techniques in ecological environmental protection, a perfect welfare system and cold weather. Kristianstad

Situated in the north eastern part of Skåne, Kristianstad is the main centre of the region. The town combines the modern and the old and is situated in an area of great natural beauty. Kristianstad is also known for its cosy cafés, restaurants and shops. Kristianstad municipality has a wonderful Biosphere Reserve known as Vattenriket, the Kingdom of water. Naturum, a newlybuilt nature centre, is situated close to the town centre and provides a number of displays illustrating the great biodiversity of the region. Here you can also enjoy beautiful views over a cup of coffee.

Within Easy Reach

Kristianstad is situated within an easy reach of Europe by air, train or ferry. High-speed trains connect Kristianstad to Kastrup Airport, Copenhagen and Malmö. You can reach Malmö by train in one hour and Copenhagen within one and a half hours. You can thus enjoy the vibrant life of Malmö and Copenhagen whenever you want. Kristianstad airport offers direct filahts to Stockholm, and other cities.

In the whole municipality of Kristianstad you can easily move by bike or on foot; there are plenty of trails that allow you to experience the beautiful landscape of the area. Some of the trails are designed for easy access by wheelchair or with a pushchair.
